## GUIDELINE FOR SUMMER TERM - 2018 (ONLY FOR UNDER GRADUATE)

### Following Rules & Regulations applicable for Summer Term:

1. It is mandatory for all failure of End Semester Examination and old failures to register for the Summer Term - 2018.
  2. The grade card of the summer term examination will be reflected with the name "Summer Term Examination".
  3. The summer term, is only for **Theory (L)** category courses.
  4. A summer course will run for the courses of First, Third and Fifth Term for Summer - 2018. These courses can be registered by only those students who have scored FF grade in academic session 2017 - 18 or prior and those who have been detained in that course. However, the students of 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> term can take advantage of this if they have opted for any of the courses and got detained in respective term.
  5. Such student will have to sign an undertaking to revoke the CAE / TAE marks secured by them in their regular/ earlier attempt in the same subject/s. Once revoked, the students shall not seek restoration of the CAE/TAE (internal) marks. At the time of registration of the subject for the summer term student must submit the undertaking stating that "My all previous internal marks of the subject registered for the summer term will be cancelled".
  6. All these students shall register with Students Section and submit the registration form on or before 20<sup>th</sup> April 2018.
  7. A student will have to pay fee of Rs 5000/- per subject to Accounts Section on or before 20<sup>th</sup> April 2018 and receipt with registration form has to be submitted to the Student Section on or before 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2018 along-with undertaking.
  8. Summer Term will be at an accelerated pace and will be at double the rate of normal semester e.g. one credit of course shall require two hours/week so that the total contact hours are maintained same as in normal semester.
  9. Student must attend all classes. If student attendance is less than 100% in any course /tutorial will not be permitted to take the Summer Term Examination of that course.
  10. The summer term will be from 2<sup>nd</sup> May to 9<sup>th</sup> June 2018.
  11. Summer Term is a special semester and students cannot demand it as a matter of right. Minimum batch size to be required and offering this semester cannot be treated as precedence.
  12. Students shall be allowed to register for maximum of FOUR courses.
