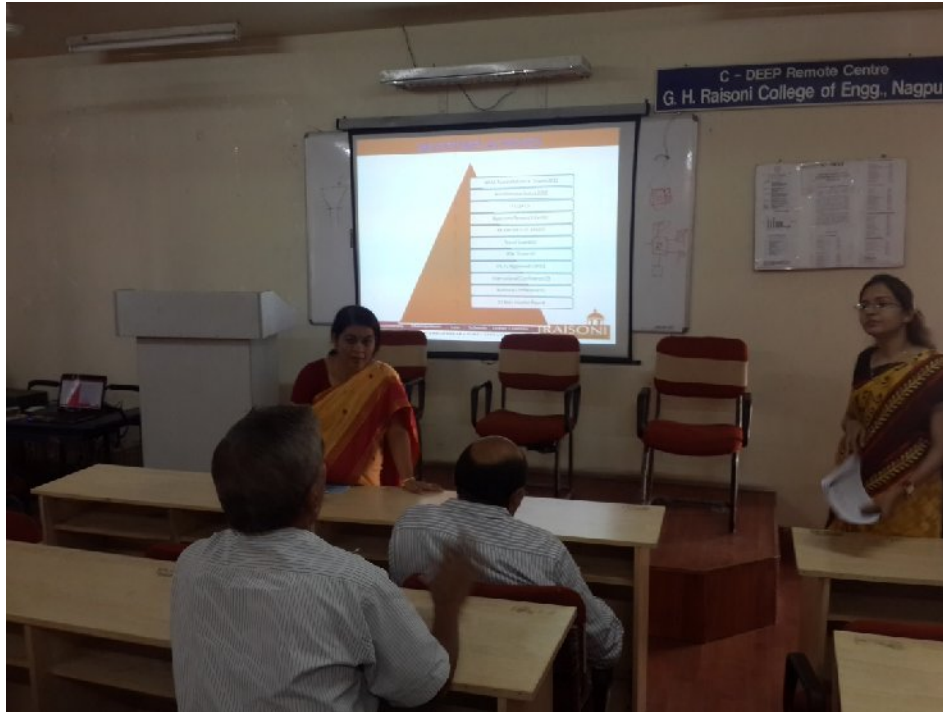
Academic Audit By External Experts
